



In accordance with Wisconsin State Statute 187.19 which stipulates that trustees are to be elected “from and by the congregation”. Therefore I, Fr. Davies Edassery, as administrator of St. Lawrence Parish, hereby announce on this weekend of May 26-27, 2018 that the trustee election is to be held on the weekend of June 23 & 24, 2018. As administrator of St. Lawrence Parish I am allowed to nominate a candidate for election and I hereby nominate Dennis Regan for an additional two year term.

Additional candidates are welcome and must be nominated in writing by ten or more parish members. Candidates must be Catholic, registered, practicing parish members, at least 25 years of age. Nomination forms are available from the Parish Office. Nominations close Sunday, June 17, 2018 at 11:00 am. If there is only one nominee, that person is then declared elected after having received approval from the Archdiocese and acceptance by signing the Statement of Understanding Form by the newly elected. And if more than one nominee, parishioners age 18 and older vote and the same after election process is to be followed.
