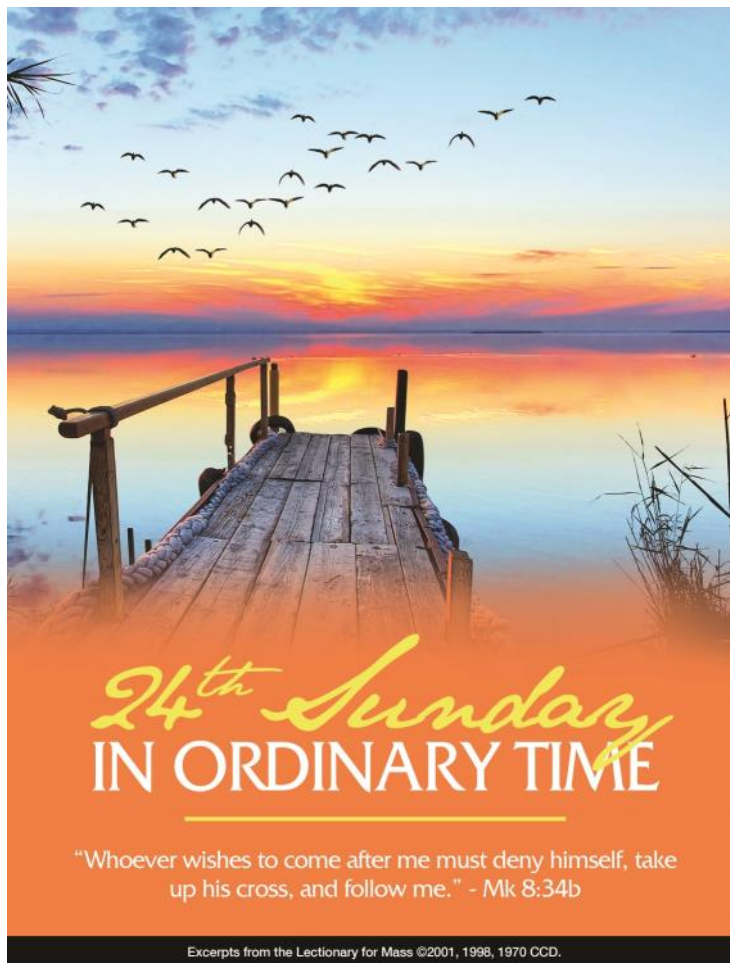

### MISSION APPEAL

Our annual appeal will be held on the weekend on **September 29 & 30** for the benefit of **Archdiocese of Benin City, Nigeria**

#### Background of the Archdiocese of Benin

The archdiocese of Benin City spans an area of 10.9 million square kilometers, with a population of about 1.9 million. Of this number, about 173,000 are Catholics; other Christians account for another million; and about 700,000 are non-Christians. The archdiocese is made up of 64 parishes; has 80 priests, one deacon; 88 female religious; 65 minor, and 65 major seminarians, respectively; 14 Brothers in formation; and 79 Catechists.

#### Purpose of Appeal

This appeal is sought to enable the new diocese build up the institutions and programs that are necessary to promote Catholic values in the area. Evangelization is a major focus here, as there is a large pool of the unchurched in this area. It is expected that any funds generated as a result of this effort will:

- Support seminary training to prepare priests for various assignments within the Archdiocese.
- Support the training and deployment of other religious ministers.
- Provide basic pastoral services.
- Support the development of Christian formation programs.
- Support the development of Catholic schools and religious education.
- Development of Archdiocesan administration facilities.
