Background of the Archdiocese of Benin

The archdiocese of Benin City spans an area of 10.9 million square kilometers, with a population of about 1.9 million. Of this number, about 173,000 are Catholics; other Christians account for another million; and about 700,000 are non-Christians. The archdiocese is made up of 64 parishes; has 80 priests, one deacon; 88 female religious; 65 minor, and 65 major seminarians, respectively; 14 Brothers in formation; and 79 Catechists.

Purpose of Appeal

This appeal is sought to enable the new diocese build up the institutions and programs that are necessary to promote Catholic values in the area. Evangelization is a major focus here, as there is a large pool of the unchurched in this area.
