We cannot send liquid or perishable items due to shipping restrictions. Kindergarten and 1st Grade: *1 Matchbox car; 1 pair of socks – various, fun; 1 small box of cereal*

3rd Grade: *3 Balls – various, can be inflatable, not too large – think fit-in-shoe-box size (boy students can bring this); 3 Hair Scrunchie Ties (girl students can bring this)*
