You may look at monthly class dates, Discipleship Sunday dates, Youth Council dates, Chili Social dates, and special activity dates, such as the 1st grade Mass Play or 5th grade Friendship Mass. I pray this will be an easy and helpful tool in keeping you informed about our rel. ed. activities.

NEW! Our Confirmation class will endeavor an online learning module this year – brand new from St. Mary's Press called a Witness to Mercy. This program will still include in-class learning sessions, along with the flexibility of at home, online learning modules. Their class schedule still follows the 6-10 grade class schedule, and their classes will remain on Sundays from 6-7:30 p.m. I pray this more active learning approach will help our Confirmands encounter Christ, become intentional disciples, and bring awareness of how to be lifelong faith learners in a busy world.

- 2. 6-11 Discipleship Sundays and K-5 Catholic Kids will occur in October April. See the online Activity Calendar at stlawrence-parish.com on the rel. ed. page for the date of your child's month.
- 3. **Sign-up Sheets** for 6-11 Discipleship Sundays, Chili Socials, Fish Fry, and Youth Mass are located in the lobby of the religious education school underneath the crucifix. Sign-up the first night of class! Orange service sheets are by sign-up sheets. Turn service hours into director.
- 4. **Faithful Citizenship** and civic participation will be discussed with special lessons and flag folding ceremony with the 6-11th grade tentatively scheduled for Sunday, Nov. 6 during class.
- **First Communion:** Completed form and material fees are due Sept. 12. First Reconciliation is 5:30 p.m. on **Mon., Nov. 21** in St. Lawrence church. Parents, grandparents, and Godparents are invited. There will be a social afterwards. First Communion is at 11:45 a.m. on **Sun., Apr. 30**, with a rehearsal on Sat., Apr. 29 from 5:15 6:30 p.m. in the church. The First Communion <u>Parent Meeting is at 5:30 p.m. in the church on Mon., Oct. 3</u>.
- Confirmation: Completed form and retreat fees are due Sept. 11.

 Confirmation dates and celebrants need to be assigned by the Archdiocese. We should receive our chosen dates and celebrant this fall. You will be notified as soon as we hear. Confirmation will be at St. Peter's. The retreat, in preparation of Confirmation, will be a day-only retreat at St. Lawrence on Sat., Jan. 21 with Mount Tabor youth_leaders. The Confirmation Parent Meeting, on Monday, Aug. 22 from 6 7 p.m. in the rel. ed. bldg., will include more information about our online learning modules and Confirmation overall.
- **Field Trip:** Holy Hill on Sat., Nov. 19 to touch the Holy Doors one last time before the Close of the Jubilee Year of Mercy. Pilgrimage is open to all and will include a Mass with Archbishop Listecki. Field Trip forms will come out in September. This field trip counts toward Confirmation.
